AHA Membership Drive

Sound Equine Options

There was discussion about making a donation to Sound Equine Options a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization (http://www.soundequineoptions.org/) that provides veterinary-directed programs to

measurably reduce the number of suffering and starving horses in Northwest Oregon and Southwest Washington. The topic will be referred to the show commission to consider as one of their benefit projects at the horse show.
